Approval of Minutes: The minutes from the June 7, 2006 and July 12, 2006 meetings were approved with corrections.

Athletic Director's Report

- The new coach for field hockey, "Coach Ram" was introduced.
- Coaches for boys and girls junior varsity soccer have been hired.
- Tony Pykosh will be the assistant athletic director for winter sports.
- MCPS has repaired the track at Montgomery College.
- October 20 is the homecoming game.
- The fields will be painted. RMHS will provide the paint.
- A request was made for a portable electronic scoreboard to be used for field hockey at JW. After researching and determining the cost would be \$2,900, it was decided that the usage for two seasons did not justify the cost.
- Costs for transportation are up dramatically causing a deficit in the AD budget.
- An invoice has been submitted to Montgomery College for expenses paid by RM. Waiting reimbursement
- Several coaches will be trained on the defibrillator.
- The procedures for recognizing seniors was reviewed: The coaches set up with a parent for the last home game.
- There may still be some schedule changes based on the sports schedule for MC.
- Coach Willard has resigned as baseball coach.
- The coaches meeting on August 14 is for the fall sports coaches.

Treasurer's Report:

- A motion was made, seconded and approved to purchase the excess concession items from the Rockville Express team for \$45.50.

New Business:

- EZ Storage has agreed to one additional year of free storage space. The booster club will continue to display the EZ Storage banner free of charge.

- October 14 will be the cluster night for football, pending approval from Leo Campion.
- Amy Wollins has agreed to be the food vendor liaison for the football season.
- Discussion was held regarding the athletic facilities at the new school. Mike Froelich will invite Laurie Bourdeaux, RM Site Coordinator to the next booster meeting.
- A motion was made, seconded and approved for Coach Burnell to purchase miscellaneous equipment/supplies for football for \$470 plus shipping.

- Arnold Lee and Cissy Palomares will continue the process of purchasing gifts (shadow boxes) for the state champions.
